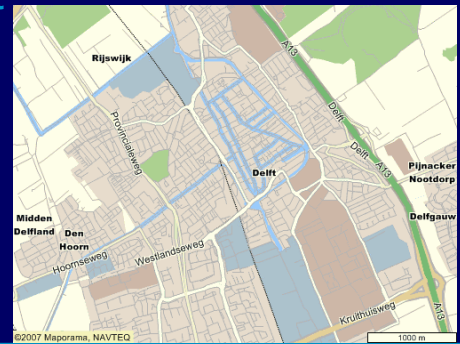
- Delft is a characteristic old Dutch city with canals, like in Amsterdam

- It originated from the "Royal Academy for the Education of Civil Engineers and Tradesmen" established in 1842
- TUD has about
 - 13 000 students
 - 2 300 scientific staff
 - 2 100 support and management staff

Department of R³

- The department R³, (85 employees, about 25 permanent scientists and 45 temporary) has a considerable expertise in research on
 - neutrons, electrons and positrons, as well as other nuclear techniques
 - physical aspects of nuclear reactors
 - radiation physics and radiation technology
 - radiochemistry
 - health and environment
